

Deep Creek Baptist Church Regathering Plan and Policies

- Our main goal is to be physically present together for our normal Sunday morning gathering to encourage, edify, and exhort one another.
- There will be no Sunday School, nursery, or child-care during the morning gathering until we feel it is safe to do so.
 - We will only have the one service at 11 am on Sunday Mornings.
- Those who are uncomfortable attending are encouraged to remain at home and continue to participate online.
- If you are feeling sick, STAY HOME
- Face masks are REQUIRED to be worn during the whole service in accordance with both State and County ordinances
 - Due to the wearing of masks and having children in the service, our service length will be shortened.
 - We do have spare masks if needed.
- We will enter and exit through the front doors and side door only
 - Entrance doors will be propped open 10-15 min before service to avoid touching door.
 - (Belltower, basement and Youth Room are off limits)
- There are hand sanitizer bottles for everyone's use at each door and throughout the building.
 - All attendees are urged to make use of these as you enter the building.
 - And after using the restroom.
- Please practice proper social distancing.
 - Please keep 6ft. distance between yourself and others (except those in immediate families).
 - There can be no physical contact between individuals outside their immediate families.
 - This means no hand- shaking, hugging, etc.
- We will have sections of the pews tapped off to provide social distancing standards and to encourage us to spread out around the sanctuary.

- A greeter will help you find a seat if needed.
- Families are encouraged to sit together
- There will be no bulletins, Pew Bibles, Hymnals, or offering plates.
 - All announcements and information will be located on the You Version app, the screens, and sent through email.
 - There are three black boxes throughout the church which you may deposit your offering in as you arrive or leave.
 - You may also continue to give online, through our website, or send a check through the mail.
- The Lord's Supper will be administered via disposable cups/wafer packs when scheduled
- Try to refrain from using restrooms, but if necessary, wash hands thoroughly.
 - The only restrooms available will be those behind the sanctuary.
 - There will be supplies and instructions for cleaning once you are finished.
- We will dismiss by rows after the service concludes and leave through the front doors.

We will modify these safety measures as time goes on and as we receive guidance from our government and health authorities.
