- ...through established practices (2)

Leviticus 19:9–10 (ESV)

⁹ “When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap your field right up to its edge, neither shall you gather the gleanings after your harvest... You shall leave them for the poor and for the sojourner: I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 23:22 (ESV)

²² “And when you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap your field right up to its edge, nor shall you gather the gleanings after your harvest. You shall leave them for the poor and for the sojourner: I am the LORD your God.”

God provides for us beyond what we deserve. (8-17)

The Gospel according to Boaz.

- He seeks the outcast.

- He shelters us. (12)

- He serves the hungry. (14-16)

God provides hope (17-23)

- Hope for relief. (17-18)

- Hope for redemption. (19-23)
